

Excerpts from the <u>771st Chemical Depot Company's Organizational History Reports</u>:

March 1945:

"The base engraver commenced engraving an inscription on the monument in Hindustani which had been previously erected in the disposal area. The monument and inscription will serve as a warning to the civilians for the next 25 years that war gases have been disposed of in this locality."

September 1945:

On the 21st of September 1945, an accident occurred at the Park during the burial of approximately fifteen thousand M47A2 mustard filled bombs. One of the bombs burst and sprayed mustard on seven men ...

October 1945:

Burial of all M47A2 mustard filled bombs was completed 12 October. These bombs had been buried because of badly deteriorated casings and it was decided not to risk shipping this type of bomb for disposal at sea because of probable leakage enroute.
